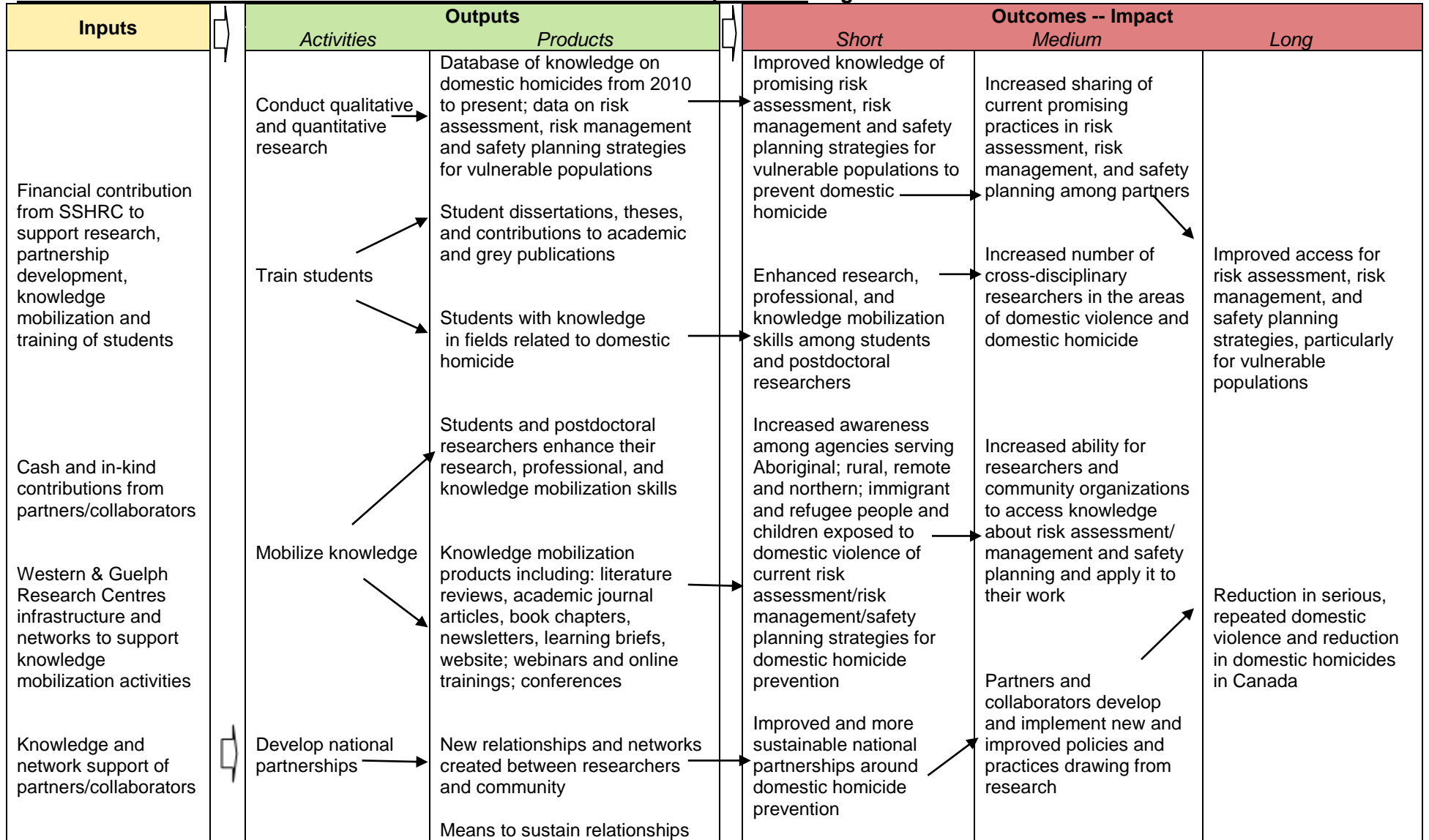


Canadian Domestic Homicide Prevention Initiative for Vulnerable Populations Logic Model



Assumptions

- There will be ongoing meaningful participation between partners and collaborators
- Unique risk assessment, risk management, and safety planning strategies are taking place in vulnerable populations
- There is a need for enhanced/new risk assessment, risk management, safety planning policies and practices, particularly in vulnerable populations

External Factors

- Political climate/bureaucratic realities around privacy, data collection, and information sharing
- High profile homicides may drive partner/collaborator priorities, potentially towards our research
- Resource availability in provinces/territories due to economic downturn
- Increased family stress contributes to increased domestic violence due to decline in economy
